## unAPPROVED MINUTES OF THE EXTRA ORDINARY PARISH MEETING

A meeting of Orwell Parish Council was held in the Village Hall on 4<sup>th</sup> July 2018 at 7.30pm (19.30hrs)

- 115/07/18**      **Apologies for Absence:** *LGA 1972 sch12 para 40 – Quorate is one third but no less than 3 members LGA 1972 sch12, para 45*  
Apologies were received from Cllr J Chuisseu (work commitments) these were agreed and accepted by all.
- 116/07/18**      **Councillors to disclose any Pecuniary Interests** (*disclosable pecuniary interests (DPIs) include interests held by a member's spouse, civil partner or similar*) listed on the Agenda:  
There were no interests declared.
- 117/06/18**      **Public participation: for up to 15 minutes members of the public may contribute their views and comments to the Parish Council.**  
There were 5 members of the public in attendance.  
Concern was raised regarding the Paddock which leads to the Glebe field and is owned by the Diocese of Ely and managed by Carter Jonas. The grass is very long and the hedges are overgrown with thistles now about to self-seed. Cllr Szembel explained that the Parish Council have been in negotiations with Carter Jonas regarding the taking over the maintenance of the paddock but they have only, in the past week, received the correct Agreement from Carter Jonas. Unfortunately, they have not indicated if they are willing to clear the area prior to the Parish Council taking it over, this includes grass and hedge cutting, checking the well and removal of the shed.

S/1394/18/FL – Barrington Cement Plant, Haslingfield Road, Barrington.  
Demolition of Former Cement Works  
To discuss the proposed vehicle route of HCV through Orwell.  
The original Project Management Plan showed HGV routes exiting the site via Orwell to gain access onto the M11. This has now been updated in the revised Traffic Management Plan which shows the vehicles will exit via Foxton Road and the A10 to the M11 so will no longer be coming through the village of Orwell. All HGV's and low loaders will enter and exit the Barrington site via Foxton Road.  
Q. (LH) Could this be revised at a later date.  
A. (GB) Possibly but if there are to be any changes then a new plan would need to be submitted. It was proposed by Cllr Bunnett to recommend 'No Recommendation' with comments 'The Parish Council must be consulted if there are any change to the Traffic Management Plan/Planning Application and reserves its rights to raise further objections, this was seconded by Cllr Tyndall, agreed by all.

There being no further business the Chairman closed the meeting at 19.55pm.
